OUR STORY

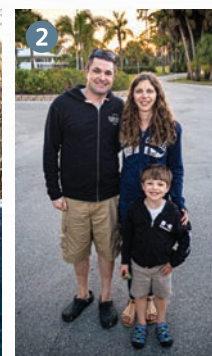

“Diane is the light of my life.

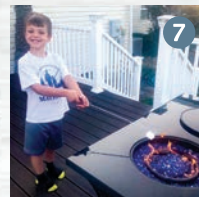

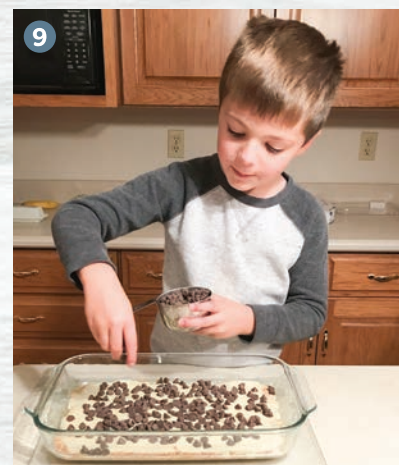
