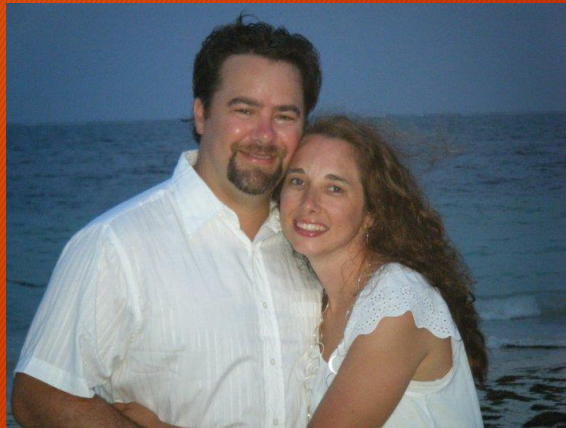
Where We Live
