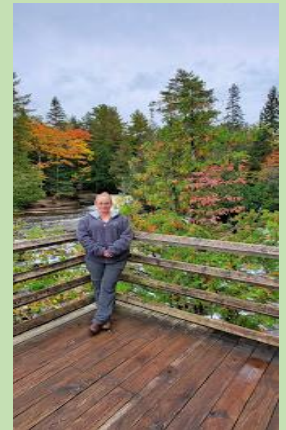

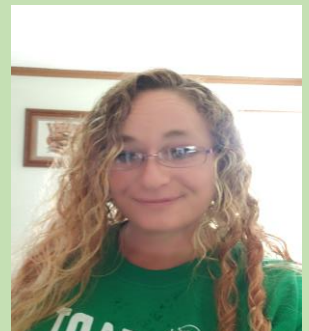
Jeremy through the eyes of Becca

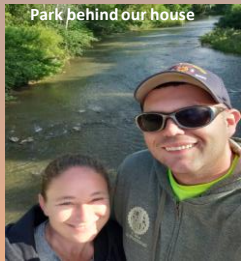

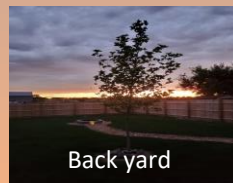

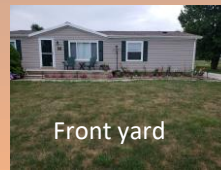
